- On August, 1st and 2nd, 2009, the Quakertown Soccer Club, in Quakertown Pennsylvania, will host the 2nd Annual Sarah Parvin 24 Hour SoccerFest. **All** proceeds will be donated to the Sarah Parvin Foundation, benefitting cancer research and programs in memory of Sarah Parvin, a QSC player who lost her battle with cancer at the age of 12.
- **This EPYSA sanctioned tournament is open to teams U-9 up to U-18.**
- **We also have non-sanctioned co-ed divisions for 19-29 year olds and over 30. These will be split into competitive and recreational (Parents wanting to just have fun) divisions.**
*We'll be taking about 120 teams, so get your registration in early. Online registration is linked from both of the above websites. Each team will be guaranteed a minimum of **six (6), twenty five (25) minute games** with the opportunity to play even more extra “Challenge” matches. The 24 hour format will allow your team to play as much as you choose by challenging other teams in a “For the Fun” style game. (Allowing for field availability)*

- *Entry fee **\$275** (Max roster size 11) All players receive Medals*

***Player cards or proof of age is required for Competition Division players, a copy of birth certificate or 2008-2009 player card is acceptable**

All participants will receive a free Tournament T-Shirt (These shirts are numbered from 1-11 and can serve as team uniforms!) and a Sarah Parvin Tournament dog tag!

- **The Sarah Parvin Classic is a tournament where our objective is to have everyone involved. We encourage parents and friends to form teams for the 19-29 and over 30 open divisions to show their stuff. We'll have brackets for recreational and Competitive divisions. Why not play some soccer and let your kids cheer you on! It's for a great cause.**
- Highlights of this tournament also include a Tent City where teams can bring a tent and camp out all night, Live Bands, Rock Climbing Wall(s), Moon Bounce, Tethered Balloon Rides and a FIFA '09 X-Box/Playstation Tournament.
- **Each division will have a Sarah Parvin Team Spirit Award**
- There will be 24 hour on-site security with partnership from the local Municipal Police Departments.
- This event provides an opportunity for players and parents from across the region to contribute in fight against this disease that affects too many, while doing what that they do best - play soccer!
